### **MOBILE SHOWER PROGRAM (MSP)**

The MSP was created and developed in QTR's 2 and 3 of 2019.

The MSP equipment was fully onsite in QTR-4, 2019.

MSP services began in QTR-1, 2020 with a goal to support the homeless in Pueblo County.

Benefits include:

- A recognition of personal value in all individuals served,
- Health and hygiene improvements that support our overall community,
- Help and supports to those without a home to improve their quality of life,
- A commitment to instill a sense of hope to those in need.

Program operations require experienced drivers, shower trailer operations, client registration, shower management, data collection, and equipment preparation for the next day of services.

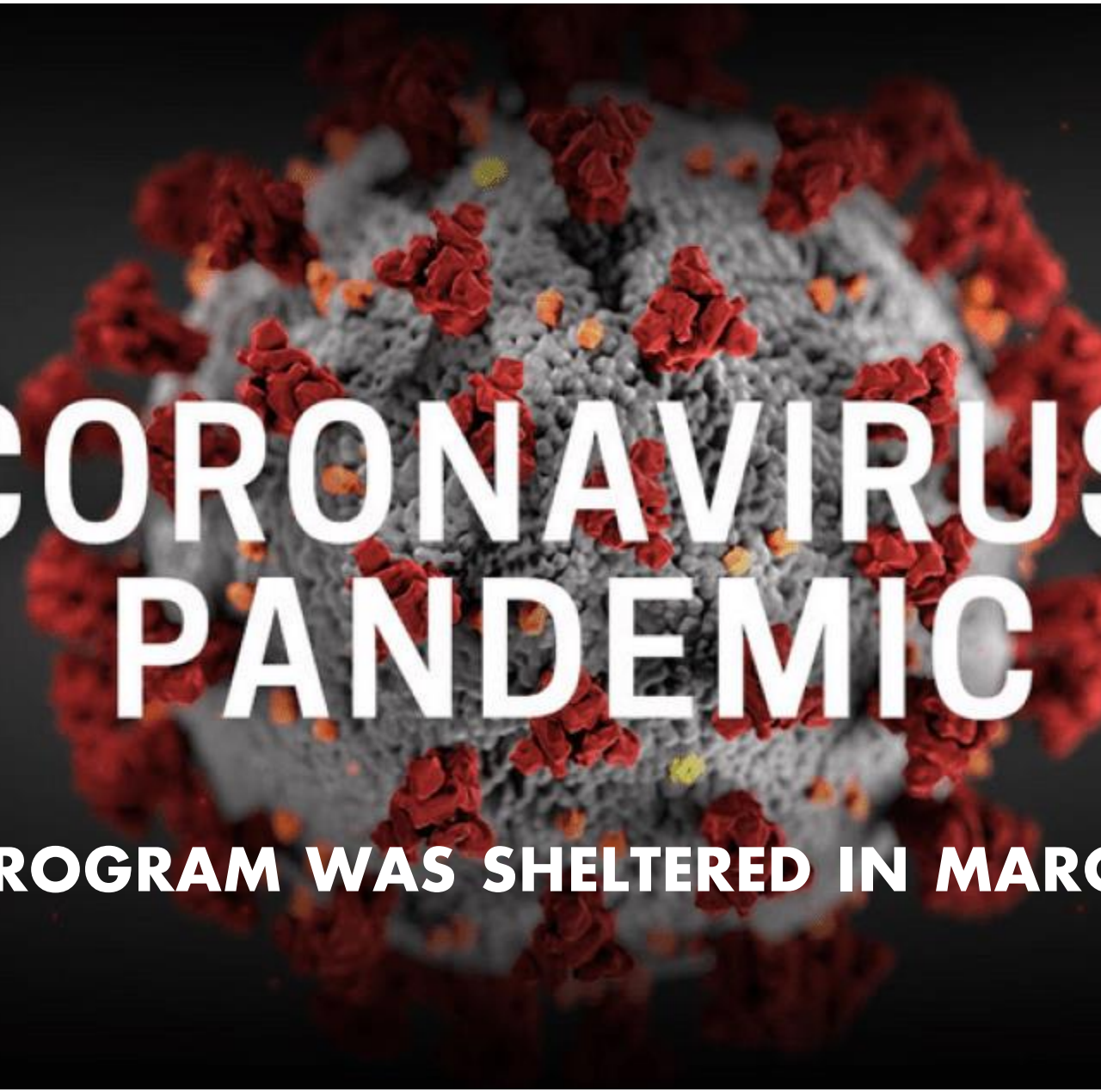

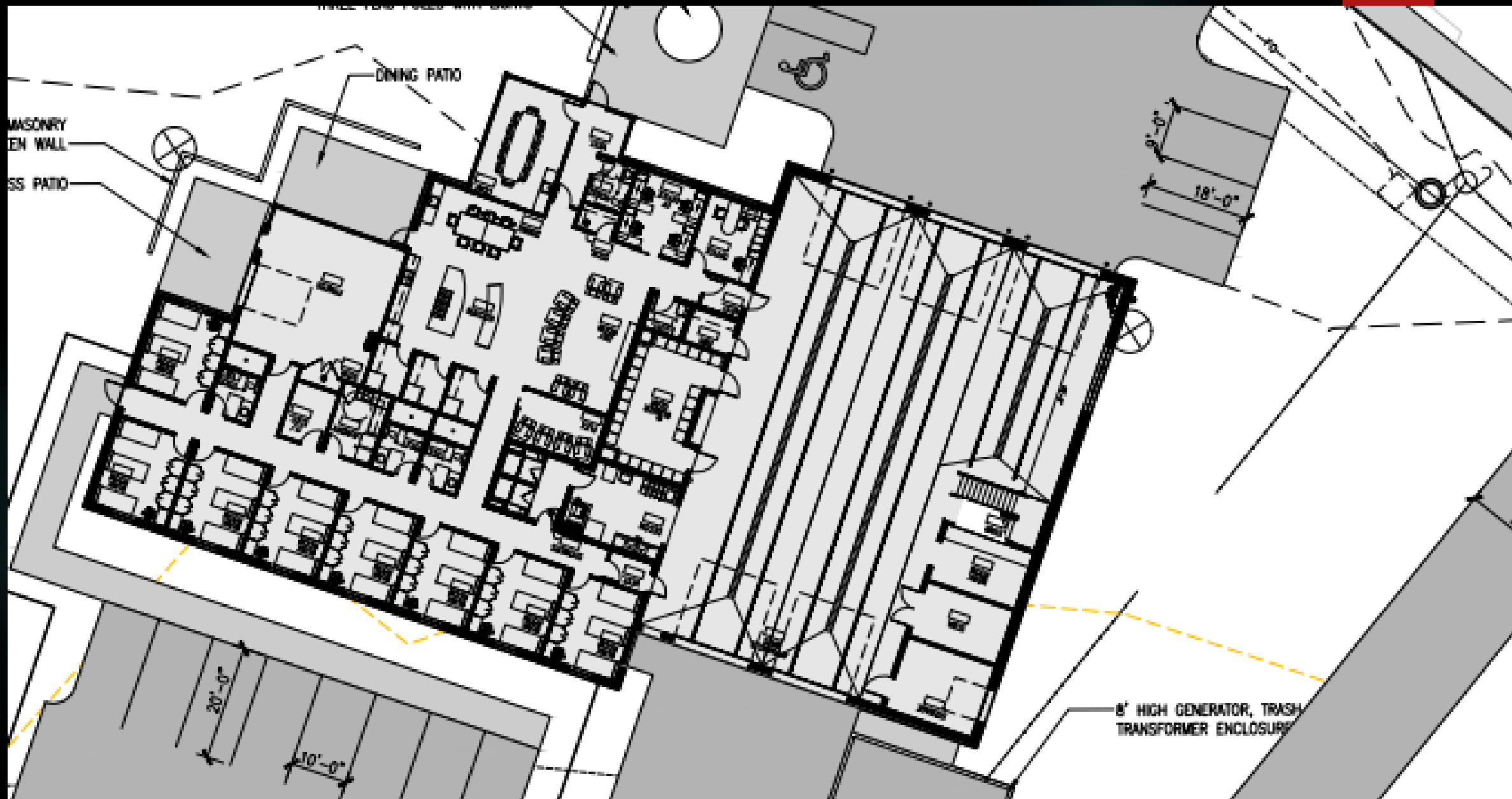

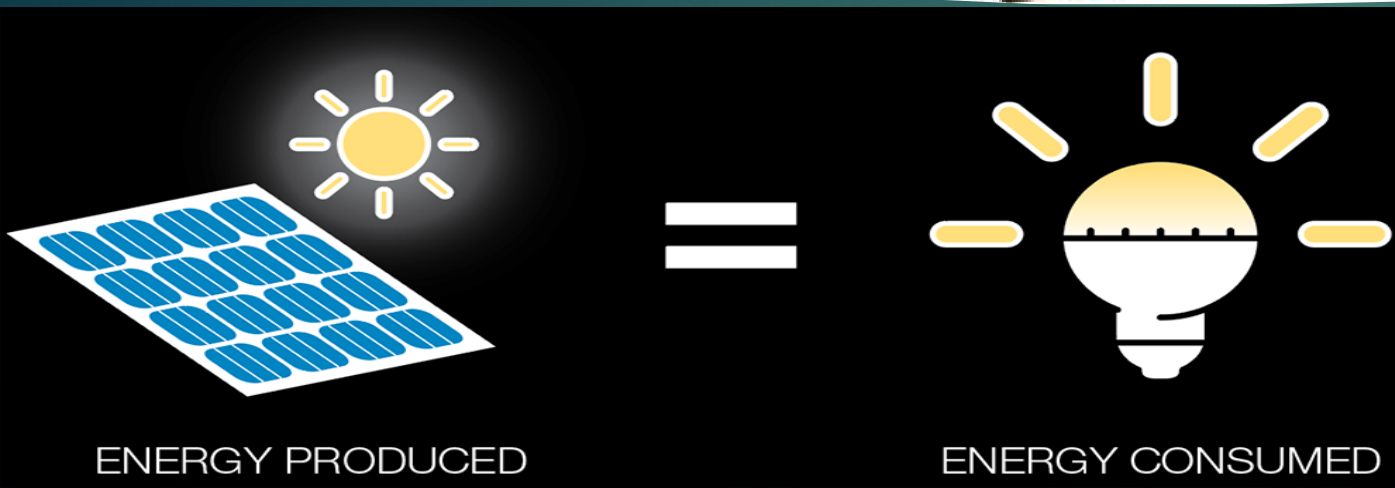

Building Design – Currently schematic design

Design Complete – 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2023

Construction Begins – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2024
