A. CITY UPDATE

Brian McCain, Chief of Staff

- Lil Dribbles basketball registration will end this week on Friday, Sept 13th
- Sept 14th is the last Movies in the Park at City Park. Movie is "Pitch Perfect" with activities beginning at 6:30 p.m. and the movie beginning at dusk
- Don't forget to submit comments to the Public Utilities Commission regarding the Black Hills proposed 18% rate increase. Town Halls with the PUC will soon be scheduled in coordination with Pueblo County
- Safety workers will check child seats on Sept 14th at Fire Station 4 for free
- 20+ officers out on overtime during Colorado State Fair, conducting over 250 self-initiated calls, made 82 traffic stops, addressed 47 parking complaints, made 10 warrant arrests, issued 56 citations, took 20 felony reports, towed 19 vehicles, and made 16 arrests
- PD handled 3,075 calls for service last week; 1,210 were dispatched to patrol officers for an average of 7 CFS/hour or 173 calls a day
