- Mitchel Park Pool is closed due to an issue with a temperature regulator valve; maintenance crews are working on it today
- City Park Pool is down due to an issue with the boiler. It is being worked on today and should reopen soon
- Street crews are patching potholes on W 29th st
- Streets completed emergency pothole repair work on Union Ave near C st last week
- Court murals and line work on the Slab courts have been completed! Ribbon cutting and grand opening soon; summer basketball season starts June 17th
