Street Piano Project

What are street pianos?

- Pianos are painted and placed in public spaces for anyone to play
- Found in dozens of cities worldwide since 2003
- Adds beauty, builds community
- In Colorado:
 - Fort Collins, "Pianos About Town"
 - Denver, "Your Keys to the City" (not active?)

Who will run the program?

- Creative Consortium of Pueblo will oversee the program
- Pueblo Arts Alliance and CSU Pueblo are partners in the program
- Pianos will be donated by community members
- We will work with local movers (ideally volunteers) to relocate the pianos
- Local artists will paint the pianos
- Local piano technicians will maintain them
- Howes Piano (involved with the Denver program) can help advise
- Donations will be solicited (e.g., via QR codes on the pianos themselves)

Where will the pianos be located?

We will prefer protected locations like overhangs and underpasses

Possibilities:

- Riverwalk - Main Street, Union Avenue
- CSU Pueblo
- Various parks around town with supporting structures
- Participating businesses
- ???

Other logistics

- Paint provides some weather protection
- Tarps possible as well
- Fasten pianos closed to discourage tampering
- Can be brought to an indoor storage during winter if desired
